Another school year—a most unique one—has concluded and I could not be more grateful and proud of the accomplishments we were able to achieve under the most challenging of circumstances. When we opened the 2019-20 school year last Fall, none of us could have ever predicted that we would conclude the year with

conference call class sessions and online instruction due to a world-wide pandemic! I am so blessed to work with our amazing CHS faculty and staff! They never missed a beat and provided our students with the same excellent quality education via distance learning that we are accustomed to providing in-person. What a phenomenal job!

I'm also very proud of how our students adjusted to their new routines and finished the year very strongly. St. Paul tells the Philippians in 4:13, I can do all



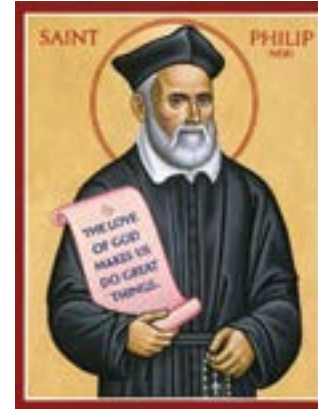
things through Christ who strengthens me. It is evident that our students persevered through this difficult time with the help of the Lord, their parents, and the entire Catholic High family.

The Class of 2020 is to be especially commended for having such a wonderfully positive attitude despite the fact that they had to miss so many of their senior activities. The accomplishments of our 145 graduates in the classroom are to be highly praised. Ninety-eight percent of the class are pursuing postsecondary education with 33 students, or 23% of the class, earning the distinction of being named a Florida Academic Scholar, the highest tier of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program. An additional 27 students, 19% of the class, were named Florida Medallion Scholars as part of the same program, leading to a remarkable 42% of the class receiving these scholarships

alone. As a group, our senior class earned more than \$13.7 million dollars in academic and athletic scholarships and grants. We could not be prouder of the Class of 2020 and pray for them daily as they bring their Crusader Spirit with them in their new endeavors.

While affected somewhat by the COVID-19 situation, our Core Value of Commitment to Service was still strongly demonstrated with 27,964 hours of student body volunteer service given to various local agencies and projects. We continue to be blessed by the many adult volunteers, from both our parent and alumni communities, who help us on various CHS committees. Their service to CHS is so appreciated; we could not accomplish all that we do without them! We are blessed to have your continued support and involvement!

As our annual Gift-Giving Campaign concludes it's 31st year and our Faith,

Hours of Screen time for all Faculty and Students

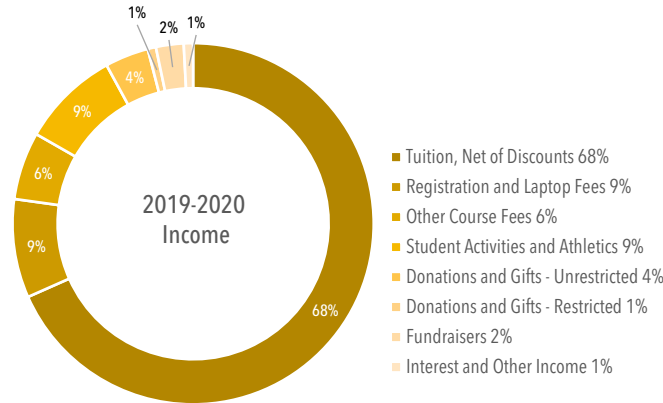

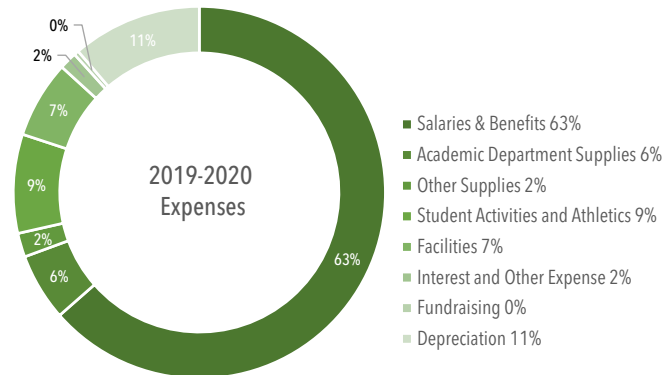

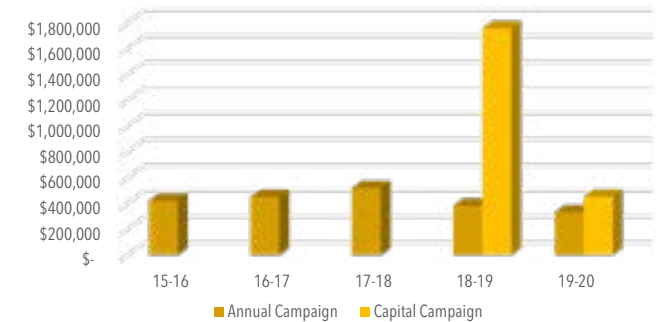

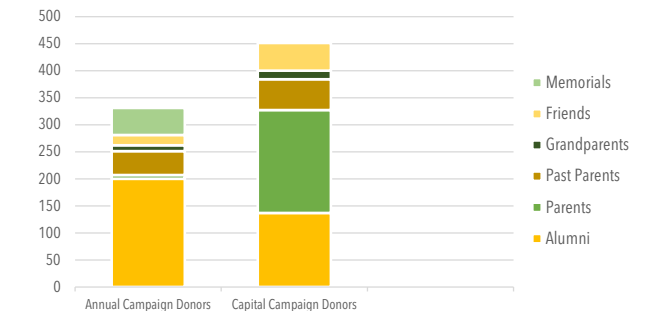
Annual Campaign Designations

SISTER KIERSTIN CELEBRATES HER 50TH JUBILEE

Jubilee [joo-buh-lee] – noun 1) the celebration of any certain anniversaries, as the twenty-fifth (silver jubilee), fiftieth (golden jubilee), or sixtieth or seventy-fifth (diamond jubilee). 2) the completion of 50 years of existence, activity, or the like, or its celebration. 3) any season or occasion of rejoicing or festivity. 4) rejoicing or jubilation.

The above is an excerpt from Dictionary.com. The year 2020 has definitely been a challenging year for any of us who planned to have physical celebrations with gatherings of friends and family. We should, however, not let the pandemic constraints diminish our rejoicing or jubilation of significant anniversaries with close loved ones or even privately with our Lord! As a

matter of fact, we are going to use the remainder of 2020 as an opportunity to have a season of rejoicing and festivity!

This year our very own Sr. Kierstin Martin celebrates the 50th anniversary of her vows by which she became an Apostle of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (ASCJ) – her Jubilee! While it has been a challenge to celebrate with a party or gathering, we want the entire Catholic High School community to know that we rejoice with Sister Kierstin and raise our voices to heaven with thanks that she was assigned to us here in Pensacola. Join us now for this written celebration of Sister's journey with the promise that we will find the right time to physically celebrate Sister, hopefully later this fall.

Both sets of Sister Kierstin's grandparents immigrated to America between the late 1800's and 1904, bringing with them the family's roots in the Catholic faith. Sister was born in St. Louis, Missouri to Edward and Margaret Martin. She is the third of seven children blessed to the Martin's and they gave her the birth name Maureen Elena Martin. She and her siblings were educated in Catholic schools in St. Louis. She attended high school at Cor Jesu Academy, an all-girls college-preparatory school founded and operated by the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Cor Jesu means "Heart of Jesus" in Latin.

Having come from two elementary schools in which she was taught by sisters of different religious communities, upon her entrance to Cor Jesu she was very impressed by the deep faith and charismatic, loving spirit of her new educators, the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. She was a good student and very involved in school activities including the yearbook staff, newspaper staff, volleyball and basketball teams, as well as many other clubs. She was a member of Student Council holding various positions

which culminated with her election as President during her Senior year. It was at Cor Jesu that she began to feel drawn by the Lord to become an Apostle of the Sacred Heart, to spread His love and to live by their spirit and charisma.

When Sister graduated in May, 1967 she knew she wanted to further her discernment into joining the Apostles and, in September, left for their Provincial House located in Hamden, CT to officially become a Postulant. As a Postulant she spent a year in religious, spiritual, and academic formation as she grew in conviction of the call to be an Apostle. After completion of her first year, Sister entered the Novitiate part of her formation and chose the name Sr. Kierstin. It was the custom at the time in her congregation to select a religious name at the time of becoming a Novice. She chose Kierstin as it is Scandinavian for "follower of Christ". Sister Kierstin has an older sister who is also an Apostle, one year ahead of her. Her sister took the name Sr. Maureen when she became a novice – Sister Kierstin's given name.

Two years later, after completing the novitiate portion of her formation as an Apostle, on August 21, 1970 sister professed her first vows as an Apostle of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. During the two-year novitiate that she spent completing her religious and spiritual formation she also continued her studies for a professional career in education, preparing to be teacher with a concentration in Chemistry and Biology. Toward the end of her formation she was assigned to an Apostle community and ministry in New Haven, CT in the shadow of

Yale University where she taught middle school science and math. This assignment was her first experience sharing fully in the community's life and ministry.

After two years in New Haven, Sr. Kierstin was assigned to a Parish in Pittsburg, PA where she taught math and science for 3 years before returning to Hamden to teach at the high school that is owned by her religious community. She taught there for nine years before getting the opportunity to teach at her high school alma mater, Cor Jesu Academy, in St. Louis. She taught at "CJ" for 2 years and in the fall of 1987, she was sent to Pensacola to join the faculty at Catholic High School. She spent her first-year teaching Chemistry and Physics to Juniors and Seniors and in the fall of 1988, she became Principal.

The aim of the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is for each sister to grow in her love for God and neighbor as they minister to God's people, working to make the Heart of Jesus known and loved by living in charity and by embracing the evangelical counsels of chastity, poverty, and obedience. We have been so blessed at CHS to have had Apostle Sister Kierstin assigned to us! As

Principal she has spent the past 32 years working to help form the students who have passed through the halls of Catholic High School into "responsible Christian individuals by providing the finest in Catholic education." She has also been the driving force behind making Catholic High the amazing institution it is today.

The Apostles of the Sacred Heart celebrate the jubilees of their sisters at their provincial house in Hamden each year. This year, due to the limitations posed by COVID-19, the Apostles decided to postpone the celebration of sister's jubilee group to the Summer of 2021 along with the sisters whose jubilee would be in 2021. So, we look forward to being able to view livestream the official celebration of her Jubilee Mass with all of her sisters in Hamden in July of 2021.

We pray to the Sacred Heart of Jesus that He will continue to bless her and keep her in his protection for many years to come. Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place our Trust in You; Sacred Heart of Jesus, we believe in Your love for us! †

Chris Gallman was a member of the CHS Class of 1999 and a very talented member of both the Basketball and Track Teams. In May of 1998, just days after he won the District high jump gold medal at the end of his Junior year, and shortly before he was to leave for the State Track Meet, he very suddenly and tragically died of an undiagnosed heart condition. His death left the Catholic High community stunned and heartbroken. Chris was a very special person – a very talented athlete, a friend to all, rarely seen

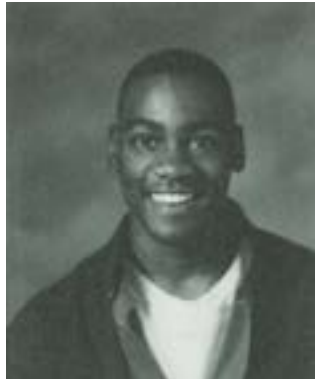
without a smile on his face and a kind word for everyone - truly the epitome of kindness and good sportsmanship.

Shortly after his tragic and untimely death, there was a ground swell of desire from all parts of the CHS family – students, teachers, administrators, parents...all, recognizing the unique goodness of Chris Gallman and asking that we establish an award in his honor...to memorialize the goodness he contributed and stood for in his life at Catholic High, his sportsmanship, selflessness, and compassion.

These qualities became the focus and criteria for the bestowal of this award that is given each year at Commencement exercises. With the input of athletes in each of our CHS athletic programs, the entire CHS faculty, and the CHS coaching staff, the selection of the recipient for the Chris Gallman Sportsmanship Award is conducted each year.

As a member of both our Football and Baseball Teams, this year's recipient is a young man who clearly demonstrated that his primary concern has always been his team's unity and integrity, and not his own accomplishments, the same selfless attributes of sportsmanship displayed by Chris Gallman.

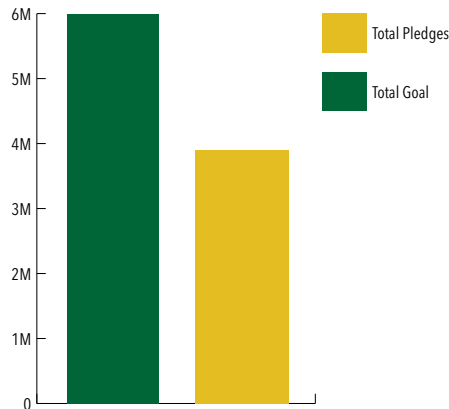
